



Missing Person and Emergency Contact Policy

Missing Person Contact: In compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, we are required to collect the name of one individual to whom notification would be provided in the event a student is determined to be missing. In the event that there is reason to suspect a student has been missing for 24 hours or more or is in threat of imminent harm and cannot be immediately reached, WLC Student Life Staff will contact the individual you designate as “Missing Person Contact.”

Emergency Contact: In addition to the Missing Person Contact information, we are also required to collect the name of at least one individual you wish for us to notify in the event of an emergency. By filling out this form you grant the College permission to share necessary information with your emergency contact at the discretion of appropriate WLC Student Life Staff (Residence Life, VP of Student Life, Health Services, Student Support Office etc.) in the event of an emergency or as applicable under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
