



Information for New WLC Students

ORIENTATION

- All new and transfer students must attend the Warrior Orientation & Welcome (WOW) Program on Saturday, January 22 from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The program will take place in the Campus Center and Warrior Underground, which are located in the Greenfield Administration Building.
- During this abbreviated orientation program, students will be introduced to key people who will help them succeed at Wisconsin Lutheran College as well as review required campus safety information.
- The WOW check-in desk will be open in the Campus Center Galleria for all new students. Commuter students should check for WOW beginning at 11:30 a.m. on January 22 to pick up their welcome packet and orientation folder.

HEALTH INFORMATION

- New students at Wisconsin Lutheran College are required to submit their health information prior to the start of classes. The online forms are available at wlc.edu/healthforms. HOUSING

- New residents should receive an email from the Director of Residence Life containing their housing assignment by Friday, January 7, 2022.
- New residents can check in on Saturday, January 22 from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m.
- Please come to the WOW check-in desk in the Campus Center Galleria to pick up your key, orientation materials, and Warrior OneCard.

WARRIOR ONECARD (ID CARD)

- New students are welcome to come to campus and obtain their Warrior OneCard prior to the start of the semester. The Technology Office is open during regular business hours in January. Please contact Technology at 414.443.8911 for more information.
- The Technology Office will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on January 22 and 3:30 to 5:00 p.m. on January 23 so new students can pick up their OneCard and get their technology questions answered. New students can also set up their computers for network access.

LOG-IN INFORMATION

- All new students should have received log-in information for their WLC email and my.wlc.edu accounts.
- You **MUST** be able to log in to both accounts prior to the start of class or you will miss important notices, classroom assignment changes, or class schedule changes. If you have not received this information, please contact the Technology Office for assistance at 414.443.8911.

CLASS SCHEDULE/TEXTBOOKS

- Class schedules and book lists are available through my.wlc.edu. Please contact the Technology Office at 414.443.8911 if you have questions about logging in to the system.
- Be sure to review your class schedule on my.wlc.edu. Even if you have already done this, you should check again because classroom assignments may have been changed.
- Some students may have been waitlisted for classes. Your my.wlc.edu class schedule will always show the most up-to-date class assignments and will show if you have been moved off the waitlist and into the requested course.
- Once you know your class schedule, you can prepare for class by purchasing books. There are no textbooks for sale on campus so you should order your textbooks online before coming to campus. Textbook information (title, ISBN, list price for new copies) is included with each course on your my.wlc.edu schedule. Use the ISBN to find books online to rent or to purchase new or used from vendors like Amazon, Barnes & Noble, Chegg, or AbeBooks. Professors include special ordering information with textbooks if you need to order directly from a specific website. If you have questions about a textbook, email your professor with the name of the course and your question about the textbook.

PARKING

- Commuter students should register their car with Trinity Home Group in the lower level ("P" level) of the Recreation Complex in order to obtain their campus parking permit and gain access to the Parking Center.
- Limited parking may be available for resident students. Students should contact Trinity Home Group at 414.443.8882 for information about campus parking permits for residents.

- Resident students will be able to use their Warrior OneCard to purchase meals from their plan beginning with dinner on Sunday, January 23.
